The following T&Cs apply to those who enrol in B² Cricket's School Holiday Program. The T&Cs will apply until further notice. If there are any changes to the T&Cs those who have applied will be notified via email.

Coach – Participant Relationship

B² Cricket Coaching ensures that all employed coaches maintain an ethical standard of behaviour premised on safety and respect.

Participants acknowledge that B² Cricket's coaches will not be held responsible for participant's physical, mental and emotional well-being that arise from their engagement with the holiday school program.

All participants mental and physical health is to be reported to B² Cricket prior to participation.

Privacy Policy

B² Cricket's School Holiday Program will operate under the B² Cricket Coaching.

B² Cricket Coaching seeks to protect its participants privacy and personal information. Each participant's privacy is protected under the *Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act* 1998 (NSW).

Participant's personal information voluntarily provided will be used only for administrative purposes. This information will not be forwarded to a third party unless necessary for the safe and successful provision of B² Cricket's School Holiday Program service. The personal information provided will be stored on B² Cricket Coaching data base. You are entitled to access and update this information.

Cancellation Policy

 B^2 Cricket Coaching will not provide a refund under reason of a change of mind. A credit will be granted for cancellations premised on injury or illness, however, such requests must be made in writing via email and accompanied with an attached medical certificate. A credit refund will be issued if the program is cancelled. The Camp will proceed in wet weather conditions.

Code of Conduct

All participants must attend to an expected standard of behaviour which at a bare minimum includes listening and following directions of coaches, respecting other participants, staff and equipment. Misbehaviour that infringes the safety and wellbeing of participants and coaches is not acceptable and may result in the permanent exclusion of that participant from future programs with no means of financial redress.

Injury Liability

B² Cricket Coaching does not accept any responsibility for injury and participants must accept all potential risk.

Medical Treatment

All participants consent to medical treatment at the discretion of which staff believe desirable or necessary throughout their engagement at B² Cricket's School Holiday Program.
